Claude Sapigao Lobusta—dedicated husband, beloved father and grandfather, and friends to all—unexpectedly passed away on September 20th, 2020 in Fairfield, California.

Born August 8, 1947 in Asingan, Pangasinan, Philippines, son to Jose R. Lobusta and Jemima Sapigao and brother to Iluminada Santos, Evelyn Galang, Jose Lobusta Jr., Erlinda Jacinto, Bernardo Lobusta, Tessie Lobusta, Joeffre Lobusta.

Claude was trained in the Philippine Military Academy in Baguio City. He continued his education and earned his Bachelor of Arts from José Rizal University.
