Colleen Weitz, Fairfield, CA passed away on Oct. 28, 2023. She was born in Cleveland, Ohio on June 22, 1939. She graduated from Parma High School in Parma, Ohio in 1958. In 1964, she moved to southern California, eventually to Nevada City, CA, then in 1966 to Napa where she remained for 43 years until moving to Fairfield in 2007.

During her time in Napa she had a son with special needs. Doctors told her he wouldn't live to see his 1st birthday. For the first 3 years of his life, he was fed through a thin plastic tube inserted through his nostril, down his esophagus, and into his stomach, a process called nasogastric intubation. Because of this, Richard is still alive today.

She worked her way through college, graduating from Sonoma State University in 1989 with a B.A. in Liberal Studies and a Minor in Sociology. She was a preschool teacher and a professional nanny for many years. She managed child care on the Napa Wine Train, which was her brainchild. She loved music and loved to travel. Through the years, she won countless ribbons for her delicious pies and cakes at the Napa State Fair. Another hobby she enjoyed was flower arranging. She decorated the clubhouse at the park where she resided every holiday and helped out at their weekly food bank.
