Cynthia Margaret Noble (Miller), of Fairfield died on February 24, 2024, at the age of 70. Born in Passaic New Jersey on November 19, 1953, Cindy as she was known by all, moved to Fairfield with her family when she was in elementary school, while her father was stationed at Travis Air Force Base. She attended Holy Spirit Catholic School and graduated from Fairfield High School, where she was the first female Student Body Vice President and upon graduating, she was chosen as one of Ten Outstanding Students in the State of California. She went on to earn a Bachelor's Degree from Chico State, which led to her fulfilling her dream of becoming a school teacher. After graduating from college, she eventually ended up settling back in her hometown of Fairfield where she married and had two children. For over 40 years Cindy was a teacher and worked mostly for the Fairfield-Suisun Unified School District where she taught children at Bransford Elementary and Cordelia Hills School. In her free time, she loved to fish and taught swimming lessons and worked at the adult school teaching English-as-a-Second Language. She retired in 2019 and loved teaching so much she continued substitute teaching until this past January.

Cindy was a devoted wife, mother, sister and daughter and she is survived by her husband, Tom Imhoff, two children Dawn Noble, Hank Noble, her stepson, John Imhoff and his wife Stacy Imhoff, her grandson and godson, Joseph Imhoff, her brother Chris Miller, and his husband Joe Piazza. Cindy is predeceased by her parents Doris and Guy Miller of Fairfield.
