Ned finished his working career at Walmart where he worked in sporting goods. It wasn't long

before his Glenn & Red's regulars visited him there. Ned enjoyed all sports and rarely missed a Giants or A's game on TV. He was an avid bowler and along with Yvonne, his wife of 74 years, he competed in numerous leagues and tournaments over the years. Ned is survived by his loving wife Yvonne, son Michael Burt (Mary Jo), daughter Nancy Nashlund (Dave), & son David Burt, 13 Grandchildren, 32 Great Grandchildren, & 3 Great Great Grandchildren.
